- Excelsior Scholarship details:
  - o Full Tuition "for eligible students"
  - o Up to \$5,500, minus other scholarships or tuition credits
  - o Does not include Room & Board, Fees, Books
  - o 2019/2020 AGI Income Test: \$125,000 and below
  - o No Asset Test only Adjusted Gross Income
- NYS Merit Scholarship
  - o \$500 / year award
  - o 3.3 GPA
  - Apply in May of Senior Year.
- NYS STEM Incentives:
  - o For Stuy student, be in top 10% of Senior Class (and confirmed by the school)
  - Attend SUNY or CUNY in STEM program
  - o NYS will pay Tuition for all 4 years
  - o There is a Live/Work in NY requirement after graduation.
  - o Apply October of Senior Year @ HESC.NY.GOV
  - At the conclusion of the business of the meeting, a screening of TESTED was held, along with Q&A with two current Stuyvesant students who were featured in the movie.
  - NYS has other special programs as well (see website).

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:47 pm, followed by the presentation of the Guest Speaker and related Q&A.
